

Refrigerant Price Increase

Refrigerant producers are advising that their capacity is continuing to be impacted by multiple production interruptions and international global warming reduction initiatives to the raw material and HFC components used to make refrigerant gas.

Demand for 2018 continues to exceed their expectations based on globally agreed targets and as a result have applied further substantial price increases which we have no alternative but to pass on. This is now in excess of 350% in 4 months.

From July 2017 there was an approximate rise in refrigerant cost of 30%. Grayson Thermal Systems continued to observe the trend, whereby other service agents have changed their prices immediately. To date, the price increase has been absorbed by GTS, in order for us to continually offer the best service and prices to our customers. However, the continued increase in costs and predictions show that these refrigerants could potentially be increasing in price per KG even further in 2018.

For this reason, Grayson Thermal System's refrigerant costs will be monitored closely and reviewed every month to ensure firstly that price rises relayed to customers are not immediately a drastic hike, and secondly, that our price increases are an accurate reflection of the market. Therefore, GTS refrigerant costs are subject to review and change every month from January 2018.



Please be aware that GTS are not in any way making profit from this position, however we cannot subsidise the cost price of refrigerant against global legislation to affect supply and demand.
